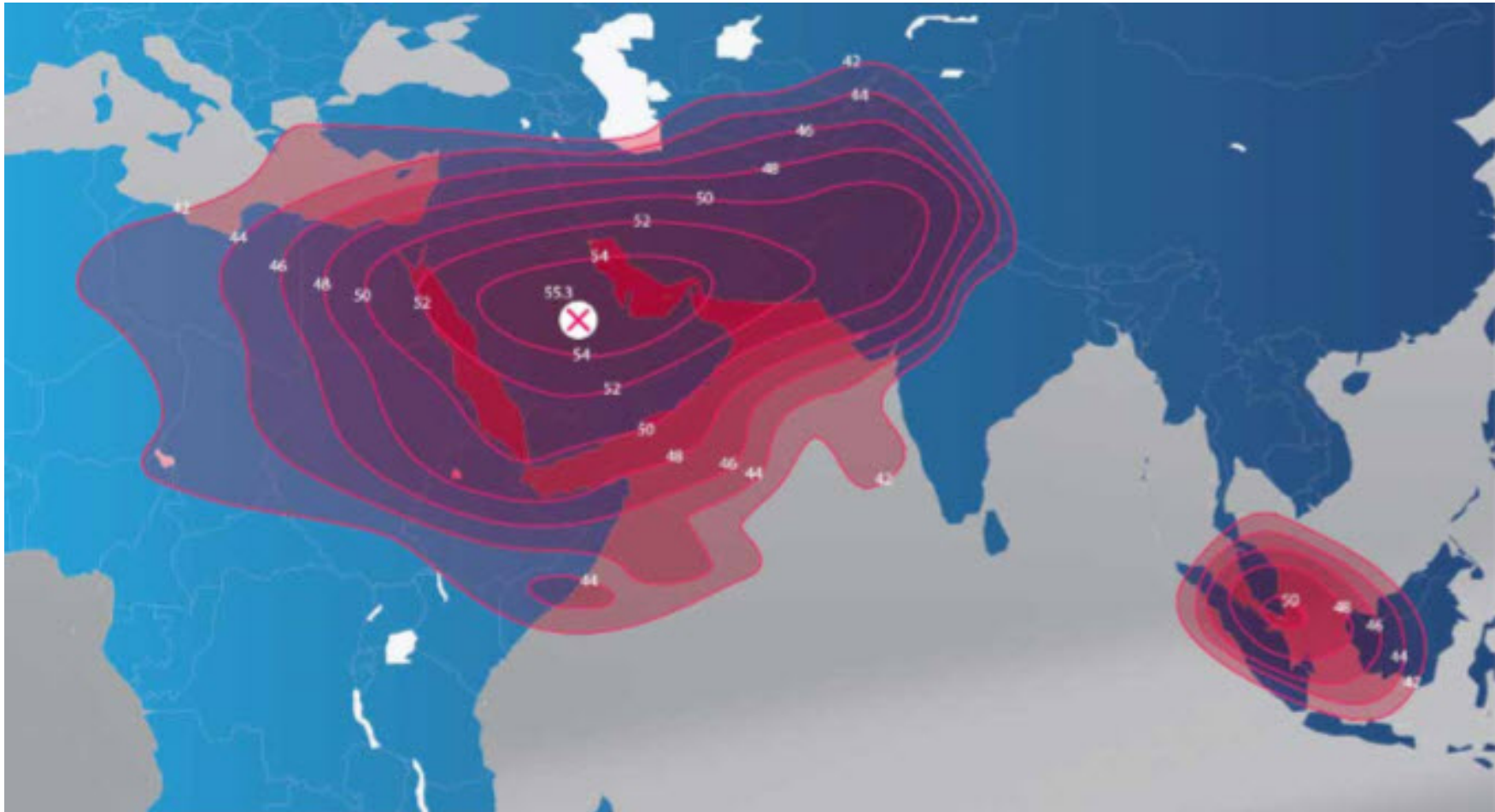


ST-2 Satellite Footprint Regional C-band Beam
